



The CSKT Warming Center, Pablo, Mt.

An abundance of compassion is what sustains the CSKT Warming Center. Sharing with others is a fundamental value we share. The CSKT Warming Center needs your compassion, love and assistance.

Most folks that spend the night at the Warming Center live in their car, couch surf with others and or are transitioning from one place to another. We believe they are unsheltered at least 50% of the time, *if not more*. We need to support them. Most of the guests at the Warming Center are males age 18 to 54. They need our consistent generous support.

With collaboration and active support, the Warming Center can continue to be a place of safety, warmth and dignity.

We are accepting donations of the following items:

- Beanies and or stocking caps as the weather gets colder;
- Warm clean gloves;
- Cotton Scrubs – *new or gently used*. The Warming Center guests frequently wear scrubs while their clothes are being washed. Soft colorful scrubs provide a break from everyday clothing. Large sizes are really appreciated. Guests take a shower and are offered scrubs while their clothes are being washed. Warm colorful scrubs are the best!
- Flash lights and batteries to provide to guests;
- Warm socks;
- Phone chargers – we want our guests to be able to communicate with family. Being connected is *so much healthier* than being isolated. We all need family connections.
- Coffee, hot chocolate and tang as well as flavored teas;

The guests need tea bags, cup of soup, small packs of nuts, and other high nutrition snacks. Packable snacks are so appreciated. These snacks sustain our guests during the middle of the day.

Donations may be dropped off at the Warming Center in Pablo, MT. or at the front desk of the CSKT Tribal Complex or in Room 211 at the Tribal Complex, Vern Clairmont Building.

The Warming Center will open from 4 pm to 8 am October 23 through October 31. On November 1 through March 31, 2026, the Center will be open 24 hours a day 7 days a week.
